<u>Uniform</u>

Please ensure that children are following the school uniform policy, as below.

Boys- Grey trousers, white polo shirt, blue sweatshirt with school crest and black shoes only. Grey shorts (Summer term & September only)

Girls- Grey skirt/pinafore/trousers, white polo shirt, blue sweatshirt with school crest or cardigan and black shoes only. Blue gingham dress (Summer term & September only)

On allocated PE days only, pupils should come to school wearing their PE Uniform- Plain white round neck t shirt

Black/navy plain tracksuit bottoms, shorts or leggings.

If your child is taking part in a sporting afterschool activity- they may bring shoes and shorts/tracksuit bottoms to get changed into at the end of the day.

Please note, that now the weather is changing, most PE lessons will be inside and therefore all children must leave a named pair of non mark shoes in school.
