As communicated to parents yesterday, due to the extension of school closures we have had to make adjudgements to our home learning plans.

Although we will still provide learning on SeeSaw and Google Classroom, we will also be providing a weekly pack of printable resources to match the activities on the above platforms. **This is only to support parents that don't have printer access.** Please note that not all activities will need to be printed and this will be kept to a minimum, where possible. We would encourage parents to use the learning through ICT if they find themselves adequately equipped to meet the needs of their child/children.

If parents opt for the pack we will ask them to come to school at a set time each Friday to pick up the pack intended for the following week.
