However, working on the plan that was made public by the Executive at the end of last week, I have outlined below some key dates for our school.

Key Dates	Arrangements
22nd February - 5th March 2021	 All pupils taught remotely via Google Classroom or Seesaw School remains open for the children of key workers
8th March- 19th March (excluding 17th March when school will close for St Patrick's Day)	 P1- 3 to return to school (9am- 2pm) P4-7 taught remotely via Google Classroom or Seesaw School remains open for the children of key workers
22nd March- 26th March	 All pupils taught remotely via Google Classroom or Seesaw School remains open for the children of key workers
29th March- 9th April	- School closed for Easter Holidays
12th April	- School reopen for Term 3 with arrangements communicated at a later date after DE announcements

As ever the above dates are very much subject to change and may be adjusted accordingly to reflect any new changes that the Executive may agree on.

As you, we remain incredibly frustrated by the current situation but there is light at the end of the tunnel and when it is safe to do so we can't wait to open our doors to all our pupils. I would like to thank you all for your continued patience and support.
